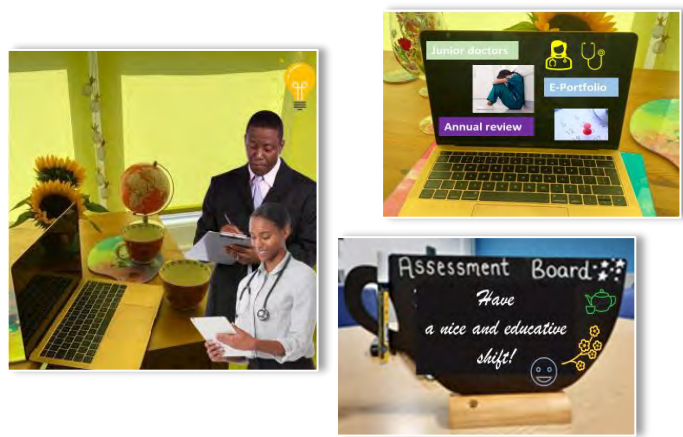
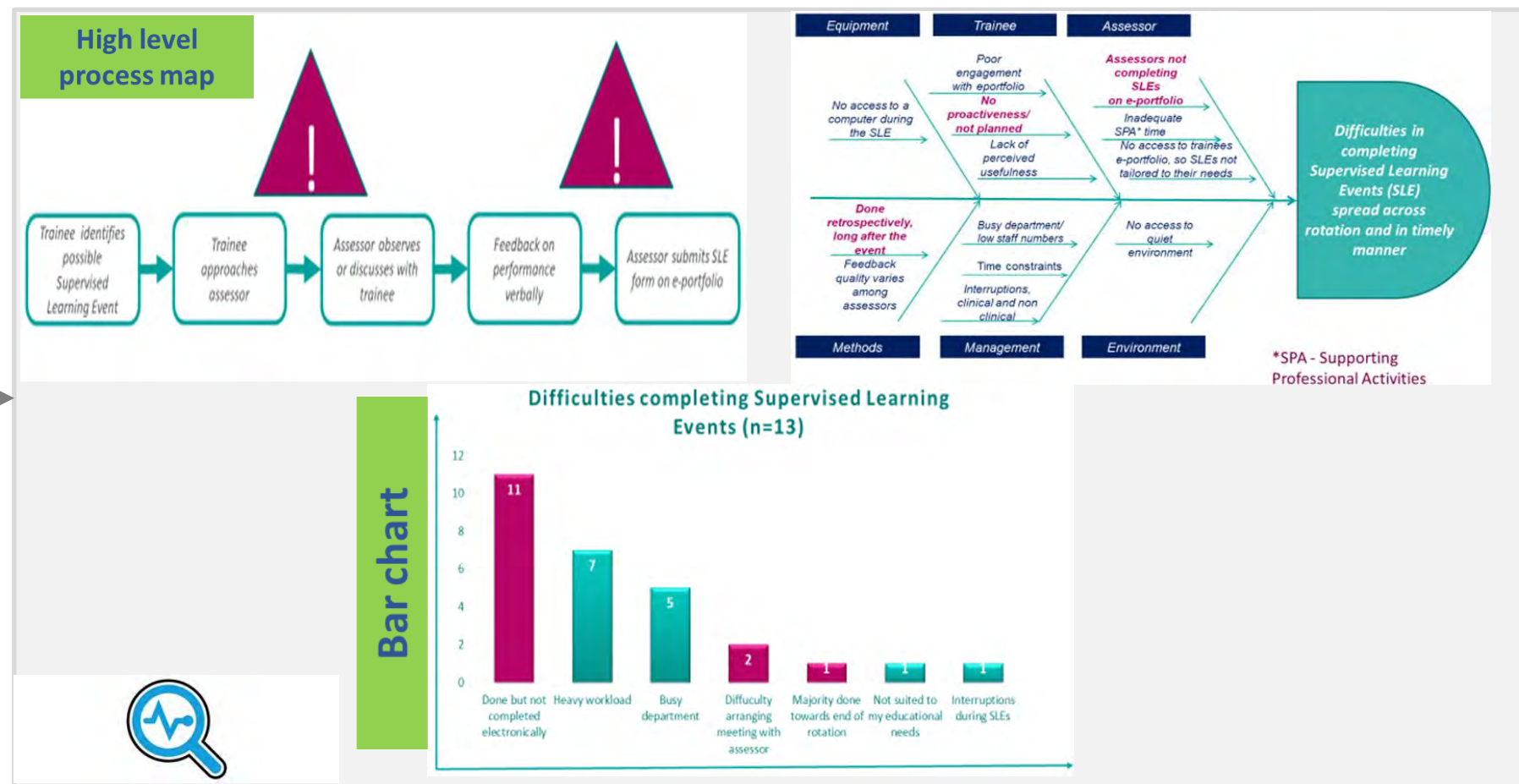
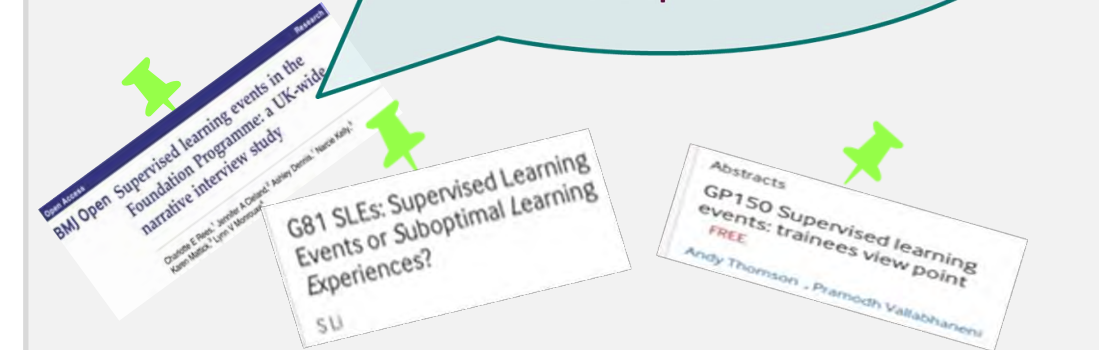


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BACKGROUND

Feedback to junior doctors is mainly via Supervised Learning Events. 12 out of 13 colleagues report difficulties completing them. SLEs end up more like a "box-ticking" exercise rather than a tool to improve performance and promote development.



Aim
By June 2022, all trainee doctors participating in the "study group" in our Paediatric Department will be receiving at least one completed Supervised Learning Event (SLE) per week, tailored to their individual educational needs

Chosen measure

- 1) No of Supervised Learning Events **completed** per week
- 2) No of junior doctors **reporting** that completing the Supervised Learning Event was **educational, according to their individual needs and ARCP requirements**-secondary measure

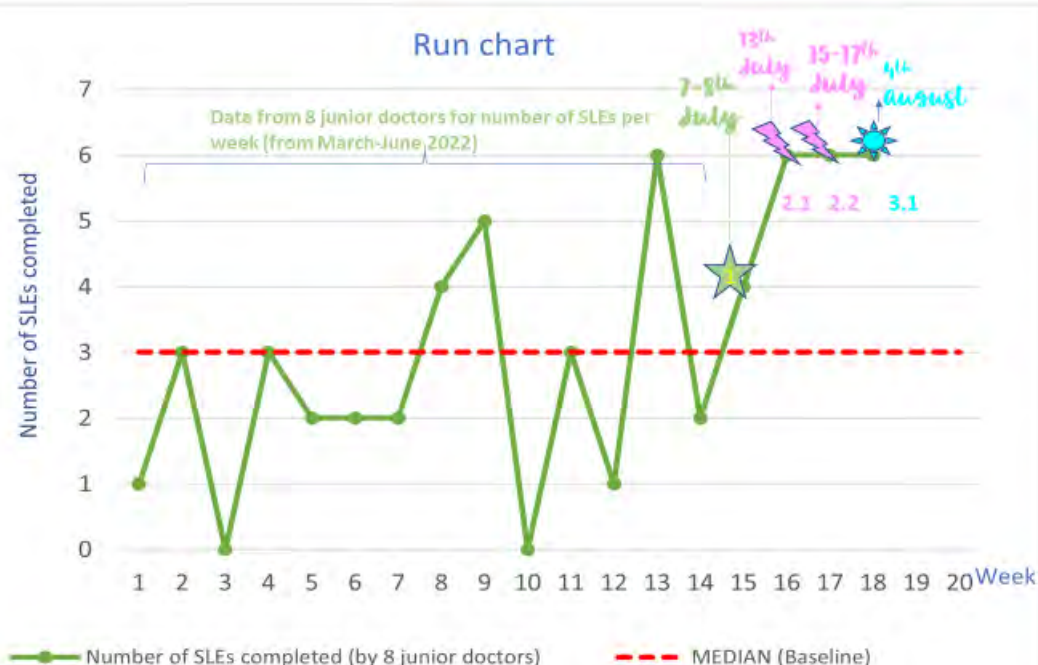
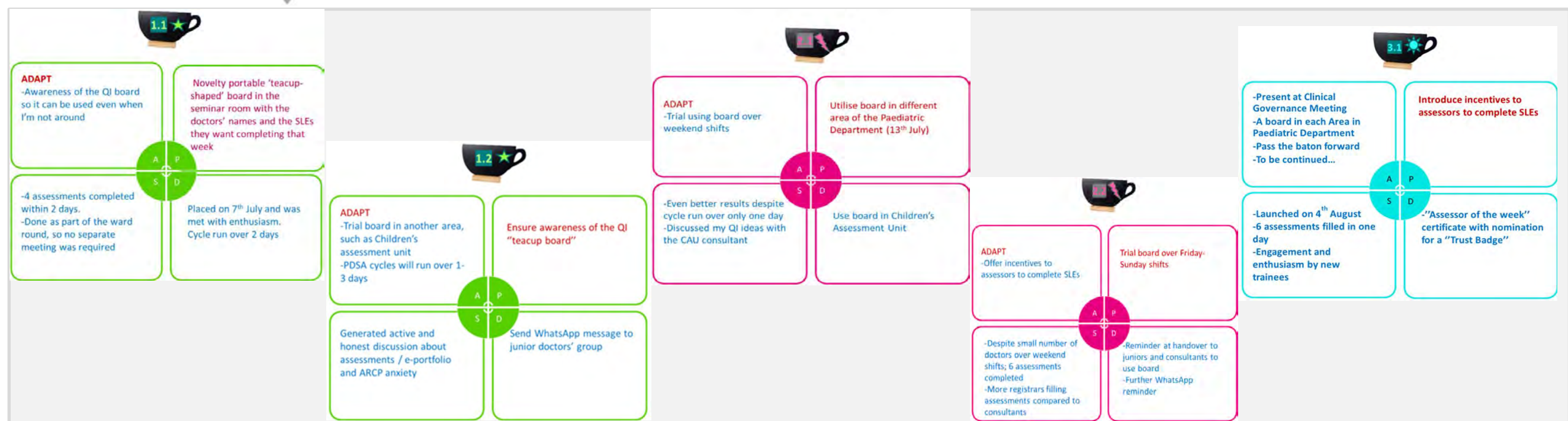
Inclusions

All junior doctors in the paediatric department **willing** to complete one SLE per week and that can engage with providing data back to me in a timely fashion

Sampling method & frequency

- 1) Retrospectively collect data on the number of SLEs completed each week
- 2) Retrospectively collect data on number of junior doctors who felt the SLE was educational and tailored to their individual needs and ARCP requirements
